- Participation in evaluation strategies
- Collect data required and report to the Service Delivery Manager
- Maintain knowledge of developments in the early years and monitor local community gaps in service delivery and relevant statistics.
- Participate in Coordinator forums organised by the Department of Education
- Convene and attend additional meetings and provide information as required e.g. for sponsors, funding bodies, and project partners.
